Dear Mr. Hall:

This letter is supplied at your request in order to clarify the status of the Emigration Canyon Road and the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) interest therein.

In 1933-35 the State acquired right-of-way deeds and reconstructed this road as far east as the Pinecrest Road Junction. Since that time the road has been resurfaced and improved a number of times, basically along the same alignment.

Jurisdiction of the road was transferred to Salt Lake County by State Road Commission action in December of 1965. At that time the State transferred to the County the roadway and right-of-way record as it existed. Any abandoned parts of the old road which existed prior to the 1935 reconstruction were considered vacated and reverted back to private ownership.

UDOT does not claim any title or interest in the property outside the roadway and right-of-way limits, as depicted on the enclosed map for Highway Project NRS-138, in the vicinity of your property in Section 31, T.1N, R 2E, S.L.M.
